Profile

I am a comparative religionist, phenomenological philosopher, and medical psychologist with backgrounds in spirituality, neuroscience, and public health. My chief research interests are in phenomenology of spiritual and religious experience, human development, a problem of representation of the first person experience in traditional texts, and human development. My areas of specializations in psychology are theoretical and philosophical psychology, psychology of spirituality, comparative psychology of religion, in addition to which I have clinical, spiritual guidance, and crisis management skills.

I published 150+ research papers, book chapters, interpretive commentaries in phenomenology of life, and a book *The Problem of Religious Experience: Case Studies in Phenomenology* (in Springer series *Contributions to Phenomenology*, to appear 2018) on the topics such as introspection, emergent religious phenomena, psychospiritual development, meditation and health, spirituality and embodiment, and theology of migrations. . In 2009-2013, I co-authored a series of research papers on visuo-spatial processing and mental imagery in Tibetan monks which were featured on BBC, Science Daily and other important forums.

My studies have included 15th century and contemporary Kundalini Tantra, 8th century Advaita Vedanta and Neo-Vedanta, early Christianity and 7th -10th century Hesychasm, contemporary Turkish and American Sufism, the Soviet spiritual underground, and the Islamic philosophy of Illumination. I have extensive publishing credits, and expertise in a large variety of research methods, including historical textual, anthropological, quantitative psychological and qualitative research, with having obtained \$500,000+ in federal and private research grants in Russia and the United States. During the last 25+ years of teaching, instructional design, program development and chairing, and student mentoring in higher education, I supervised more than 40 doctoral dissertations, some of which were conducted at the Neurophenomenology Center which I founded and directed at the former Institute of Transpersonal Psychology in the Silicon Valley, California. At present, I am a Founding President of the Society for the Phenomenology of Religious Experience (SOPHERE) .

I worked with disadvantaged communities prior and after the terrorist events of September 11, 2001, in Turkey, in the United States, and in the UK after the bombings of London Tube. In pre-perestroika Russia, I volunteered in trauma relief in Estonia, Moldova, and Central Russia. The Hridayam® Public Health and Spirituality Program , which I developed and taught, was offered in 6 countries, to more than 5000 people. I conducted diversity trainings and consciousness development seminars in England, Romania, France, and the United States. My knowledge of languages includes fluency in Russian and English; basic level of Sanskrit and Arabic; and limited written German, French, and Italian.
